Entry space in the tournament fiel	d is limited to 36 teams of four players each. Teams

Entry space in the tournament field is limited to 36 teams of four players each. Teams will be assigned to holes by Lottery Random Number Generator. Every attempt will be made to include all teams that register in the playing field. Standby lists will be kept. While reserving your space, full payment is the only guarantee of space at the tournament. If a team has not paid in full by the registration deadline, teams on the standby list will be admitted in that team's place. Any partial payment for a team that forfeit's its space will have their registration fees returned.



Official Rules:

STATE OF IDAHO EMPLOYEE GOLF CLASSIC

- 1. Men shall tee off from the blue tees (course length is approximately 6,052 yards) and the ladies from the Gold tees (course length is approximately 5,031 yards).
- A scramble means that all four team members tee off on each hole and then decide which tee shot they like the best and mark the spot with a tee or ball marker.
 - Each team must use a minimum of one tee shot per player for each 9 holes during the round.
 - Captains will keep a tally on their score cards.
- After the tee shot, the other team members pick up their balls and place them within one club length (no closer to the hole) of the marked spot. Each team member hits their next shot from the chosen spot of the prior shot.
- 4. If the team chooses to play a ball that is in a hazard, sand trap, the rough, or out of bounds, players may not drop the ball outside of the hazard or rough even if relief is within one club length away.
 - All players must play from within the hazard, rough, or out of bounds area.
- 5. This procedure is followed on every shot for the remainder of the hole, including putts.
- 6. The ball should be marked on the putting green also
- 7. Putts need to be made from within 3 inches of the marked spot (no closer to the hole). The first ball to go in the hole is counted for the team score.

IMPORTANT: If a putt is missed, the ball must be marked and all team members allowed an attempt from the first location. "Putting out" a missed putt will count as the team's FINAL score for that hole. All other team members will forfeit their putt attempt.

8. The maximum score allowed on an individual hole is double-par for the hole being played. After that score is reached, teams are encouraged to pick up and move on to the next hole.

GOLF ETIQUETTE:

- 1. Please smooth all marks made in sand bunkers.
- 2. Leave the putting green as soon as you have holed out.
- 3. Do not play until the players in front of you are out of range.
- 4. Balls may be cleaned on the green and ball marks repaired prior to putting. You may not repair spike marks prior to putting.
- 5. Please observe all local course rules.
- 6. Enjoy the day and your fellowship with other State employees!

MULLIGANS:

A mulligan may be used at any time during the round. Each player has jurisdiction over their mulligan's use. Once the mulligan belonging to a player is used, the player must sign the mulligan and list the hole where it was used. At the end of the tournament, team captains will return used mulligans to be entered into a prize drawing.

AWARDS: The following categories may be awarded. Team Awards:

- 1st Place
- 2nd Place
- 3rd Place

Individual Awards:

- Closest to pin (Men & Women)
- Longest Drive (Men & Women)
- Lucky Lottery Hole
- and more

DOOR PRIZES: Only one entry per person. ALL door prize drawings will be held at the tournament banquet. **Players MUST be present to win door prizes.**

NOTE: All rules are subject to change by the tournament committee.

TIES: In the event there is a tie for first, second and/or third place, the Tournament Committee will use a Scorecard playoff for the tiebreaker. Sudden death, low score wins, starting with the highest handicap hole until the tie is broken (#1 handicap, then #2 handicap, then #3 handicap and so on). In the event that all 18 holes are used the tie remains, "Rock, Paper, Scissors" - best out of 7 - will be used by the Team Captains to break the tie.
